SMDTC is very pleased that Joan Meyer will be returning for another advanced agility seminar. The 2011 Two-Day Seminar will be an Advanced Handling Seminar for AKC Open and Excellent dogs. This seminar is limited to 15 working teams and **unlimited auditors**. Auditors are welcome and can really learn a lot through observation. We will also offer 12 private lessons for 30 minutes each with Joan on Friday October 7th from 12:00pm to 6:00pm. Private lessons will be offered to our past seminar participants, current registered seminar participants and SMDTC club members until October 1th. After October 1th, private lessons will be open to the public on a first come first serve basis. Private lessons are open to all training levels of dogs. The cost of the Friday private lessons are: \$60.00 for a 30 minute private lesson, \$75.00 for non seminar participants. Joan began competing in agility in 1993. She is nationally known for the wide variety of breeds and number of dogs that she has handled. With over 300 agility titles on dogs ranging from the 8-inch class to the 30-inch class, from the herding, sporting, terrier, non-sporting, toy and hound groups, she has had the experience to work with all breeds and sizes of dogs in the sport.

Joan is a top agility instructor, World Team member, and AKC Judge. She uses positive training methods to work toward the goal of developing the best agility team that is possible. We are very lucky to have her for this two-day seminar.

During this seminar, Joan will work with both Intermediate and Advanced level teams. The seminar is limited to 15 working teams. **Intermediate and Advanced teams must be competing at the AKC OPEN or EXCELLENT level.** There is unlimited space for auditors.

Each team will work both days all day. Auditors may also walk sequences/courses and are encouraged to help with course building and bar setting. All participants are encouraged to take notes.

Take 44 just one exit up (Exit # 67), then turn right on "T" Hwy, go 2 miles, you will come to a stop sign, go straight over 266, which is Chestnut Expy. go another 2 miles until you come to intersection EE, and make a left on 116 (same road), go 1/2 mile and we are on the left hand side of the road.
